

# HYPOALLERGENIC

Support with feed intolerance and allergy

Does the cat itch often or even have bald patches? These are usually symptoms of feed intolerance and allergy – and you don't have to just accept them. With Josera Help Hypoallergenic you can help your velvet paw to feel better.

The hypoallergenic special diet is particularly well tolerated thanks to salmon protein as animal monoproduct and is well suited for sensitive cats. If an allergy or intolerance is suspected, an exclusion diet can help: In this case, the cat is given a feed that is completely new to it. If there is an improvement in symptoms such as itching or diarrhoea during the exclusion diet, it is very likely that the cat is allergic to or has developed an intolerance to an ingredient in the previously given feed.

With Josera Help Hypoallergenic dry feed, the cat can finally nibble courageously again – and do without itching.

## Salmon protein

Salmon as an animal monoproduct forms the ideal basis for a hypoallergenic feed. It is easily digestible and provides the cat not only with high-quality protein, but also with valuable fatty acids.



## Recipe that supports digestion

The recipe with dietary fibres can promote the growth of healthy intestinal flora and regulate digestion. By binding water, the fibres also stabilise the consistency of the faeces.



## Limited recipe

Selected, easily digestible ingredients and a reduced number of protein sources used offer an alternative for animals with feed intolerance and allergies.

### Feeding recommendation:

Weight	inactive / older	normally active / active
2-3 kg	30-40 g	40-55 g
3-4 kg	40-50 g	55-65 g
4-5 kg	50-60 g	65-75 g
5-7 kg	60-70 g	75-95 g
7-10 kg	70-90 g	95-120 g

Feeding recommendation per day.

Ensure that your pet always has access to fresh drinking water.

For optimal effect, only feed the diet feed.

Additional feedings must be discussed with the attending veterinarian in advance.

For nutrient intolerances: recommended feeding duration 3 - 8 weeks; can be fed indefinitely if intolerance symptoms are lessened. It is recommended that a veterinarian's opinion be sought before use and before extending the period of use. Protein sources: salmon, pea, potatoe. Carbohydrate sources: pea, potatoe.

### Grain-free complete dietary feed for adult cats with feed intolerance and allergies.

**Composition:** dried salmon protein 30.0 %; dried potato; pea flour (natural source of amino acids); poultry fat; dried beet pulp (natural source of dietary fibre); potato protein; hydrolysed fish protein; minerals.
